

Schlarman Hall of Fame Nomination Guidelines

<u>Alumni Nominations</u>

- Candidate shall have had recognized achievements as a student at Schlarman.
- Candidate shall have been a supporter of Schlarman after graduation through volunteering of time, financial support, donation of skills or other activities which promote Schlarman and its continuation.
- Candidate shall have graduated at least ten (10) years prior to selection.
- Candidate shall have contributed in one or both of the following areas:
 - Significant service or personal commitment to his/her community.
 - Particular recognition in his/her job or chosen profession.

Honorary Nominations

Candidates shall have been an outstanding supporter of Schlarman through volunteering of time, service on boards or committees, donation of skills, attendance of family at Schlarman and or financial support.

Voting Procedure

Members of the Schlarman Hall of Fame Committee include: Principal, Development Director, Schlarman Foundation President, Advisory Committee Chair Representative and Alumni Representative. Members of this Committee will consider the proposed nominations. Names must be submitted in a uniform format using the Schlarman Alumni Association Hall of Fame Nomination form on the Schlarman website: www.schlarman.com. The person making the nomination <u>must</u> sign the form and mail it to: Schlarman Development Office, Attn: Christina Dietzen, 2112 N. Vermilion St., Danville, IL 61832. No anonymous will be considered. There will be no exceptions.

Deadline/Timeframe

Deadline to receive nominations is second Friday in December. The Committee will meet to review nominations after that date. Selection of a date will be determined by the Principal for a home boy's basketball game in February.
